

Addressing complexity


E.g., New trends in data/ evidence, technological innovation, advances in science, cross-disciple nature of problems, etc.


SO2: Preparedness for future risk analysis needs



- Harmonised risk assessment culture at EU level
- Improved quality and scale of crisis preparedness and the identification of emerging risks
- Improved quality of scientific guidance and methodologies so as to address future challenges
- Preparedness for future regulatory and policy needs (Farm to Fork, Biodiversity and Chemical strategies)
- Wider access to and broader exploitation of data and analytics


